Meet the E-QUESTRIAN TIME panel!

- ★ YOGI BREISNER** - Needing no introduction, Chef d'Equipe of the medal winning British Eventing Team, Yogi has become one of the country's most successful and respected trainers of both riders and horses. As a rider he competed successfully in dressage, show jumping, horse trials and point-to-points.
- ★ PAT EDDERY** - Now a racehorse trainer, Pat is the second most successful flat jockey of all time having ridden 4,632 winners, including the Epsom Derby 3 times and also winning every major flat race including the Arc de Triomphe on several occasions. He was champion jockey 11 times, a record shared with Lester Piggott.
- ★ DAN SHERRIFF** - International Dressage Rider who has trained many horses from scratch to Grand Prix level, winner of the 2011 Hickstead CDI Grand Prix freestyle, placed at Pompadour and Hickstead CDI's and currently competing internationally on Bayford Hall Dallaglio.
- ★ CORRINE BRACKEN** - Corrine is a former International Rider. She is Chef and Team Coach for the GB Children's, Junior and Young Rider Show Jumping Teams. In addition, Corrine is BEF Equine Pathway Manager, BS and UKCC Accredited Coach and in her spare time she is the Show Jumping Coach for Hartpury College.
- ★ JONATHAN CHAPMAN** - Chairman, B.H.S.I. is Team Coach to the British Eventing European Two Star Team, and was a member of that Gold medal winning team in 2011. He successfully competes in eventing up to 3 Star Level, is a popular local coach to riders of all levels and is Chairman of the Safety Committee for British Eventing, hence his role in this event.
- ★ SARAH WICKS** - Sarah has been riding since she was 5 years old and has worked for Baileys Horse Feeds for 10 years. Sarah works alongside top Racing Trainers through to Olympic Event Riders formulating suitable diets for their performance horses.
- ★ ANDY SPRINGHAM** - A renowned and well respected remedial farrier with a special interest and expertise in laminitis, Andy works closely with the RSPCA.
- ★ GAVIN HAMER** - Graduated at the Royal Veterinary College and holds the European School of Veterinary Post Graduate Studies Specialisation in Equine Practice. He has a particular interest in lameness investigation, dentistry and pre-purchase examinations.
- ★ FRANCESCA COMPOSTELLA** - Fran has had several years experience of working in England, Scotland, Ireland, America and Italy both in referral and 1st opinion practice. In December 2011 Fran completed a three year ECVS approved Equine Surgery Residency at the University of Bristol. Fran's particular interest is working with race and competition horses in the fields of sports medicine and soft tissue surgery.
